(Vetiveria zizanoides) Botanical Family: Gramineae (Graminaceae)

Perennial grass growing up to 2 metres high. The roots are very long and rhizomatous.

Plant Part used: washed, dried, sliced, or ground, roots

Method of Extraction: steam distillation

Countries of Production: Indonesia, India, Haiti

Fragrance: earthy, musty
