damaged

dry

mature

prematurely ageing

burns *mobility of tissue*

crow's feet *rejuvenating*

scar tissue *regenerative*

scarring *toning*

wrinkles

often sold

deodorised

Contains:

Linoleic and linolenic fatty acids, oleic acid, rich in transretinoic acid, vitamins including A, proteins, minerals.

Source:

From the seeds, by solvent extraction. Produced in Chile.

Colour

Orange/reddish gold

Can be used undiluted on specific areas, or diluted at 20 per cent for more general use.
